## **TENNIS RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **Member Play**

The tennis facilities are open to Club members and their families. Play will be restricted to Club members only and invited guests.

### **Court Time**

The courts will be open for play daily from 8:00 A.M. until 11:00 P.M. During off hours, the courts will be locked. After 5:00 P.M. and all day on weekends and on holidays, adults will have priority for court play.

### **Court Reservations**

Members may reserve a court for one-hour intervals.

### **Proper Dress**

Only tennis attire will be permitted for play on the Courts. Blue jeans, swimsuits and cut-offs will not be allowed. Halter-tops and beach type muscle shirts are not acceptable. Shoes must have soft rubber shoes.

### **Food and Drink**

Food and drink (except water) will not be permitted on the playing area. Food and drink will be allowed in the tennis shelter area adjacent to the south end of the swimming pool.

## **Night Play**

Each court has a switch for lights at the central control box located at the foot of the bridge courtside. Please use only those lights that cover your court if the other courts are vacant. Also, if you are the last to leave, we ask that you turn off the lights.

## **Guests**

Members may invite non-member guests. Any guest, however, must be accompanied by the member. The guest fee is \$5.00 per day. If no one is at the tennis shop, all guests must register at the golf pro shop. Failure to register guests will result in suspension of guest privileges for the member

## **Lessons**

Lessons by the half-hour or by the hour will be available by appointment with the Tennis Professional.

## **Clinics**

The Tennis Professional will organize and operate clinics for members and their families. The Tennis Professional will determine the charges for clinics. The schedule for clinics will be available at the Tennis Shop and will be published in the Newsbreak.

## **Court Courtesy**

1. Do not retrieve your ball from or behind an adjoining court while play is in progress.
2. Do not ask for your ball or return a ball to the adjoining courts while play is in progress.
3. Return a wandering ball to the server of the match.
4. Waiting for the court; Remain on the sidelines until players are finished without distracting them.
5. Do not enter the court or walk across or behind a court until a game is completed.
6. Please observe the one-hour time limit for play when other players are waiting.

### **Spectator Courtesy**

1. Spectators must show consideration for the players by avoiding distracting movement and loud conversation while a point is in progress. Do not ask for the score until the score is determined after a point.
2. Do not move around, change seats, rattle paper, leave the court area or wave at other spectators during a point.
3. All spectators, including parents and friends, should be courteous. This means no volunteering advice on time calls, scoring or conduct of the match while play is in progress.

### **Evening Dining for Tennis Players**

Tennis players in casual attire are welcome in the Terrace Room and the Grill before or after their tennis matches.
